Coupling a disarming sense of technical adeptness with a natural gift for imbuing the common with a seductive feel, pianist Lynne Arriale celebrates the 10th anniversary of her trio with bassist Jay

Anderson and drummer Steve Davis on *Come Together*.

The benefits of these longtime associations readily play out on each cut, from the opening invocation of The Beatles' title cut to the sensuous and sumptuous sway of the New Orleans traditional "Iko, Iko." Yet far more remarkable are Arriale's original compositions. Ranging from the gentle grace that characterizes "Sea And Sand" to the bravada that plays out in the twists and turns of the raucous "Braziliana," Arriale's ability as both a melodicist and an intensely rhythm-centric soloist come to the fore within the context of her own tunes.
